

PRIVACY POLICY:

Ambulatory Neurological Services, LLC ("Ambulatory Neurological Services") operates ANSEEG.com and may operate other websites. It is Ambulatory Neurological Services' policy to respect your privacy regarding any information we may collect while operating our websites.

Website Visitors

Like most website operators, Ambulatory Neurological Services collects non-personally-identifying information of the sort that web browsers and servers typically make available, such as the browser type, language preference, referring site, and the date and time of each visitor request. Ambulatory Neurological Services' purpose in collecting non-personally identifying information is to better understand how Ambulatory Neurological Services' visitors use its website. From time to time, Ambulatory Neurological Services may release non-personally-identifying information in the aggregate, e.g., by publishing a report on trends in the usage of its website.

Ambulatory Neurological Services also collects potentially personally-identifying information like Internet Protocol (IP) addresses for logged in users and for users leaving comments on various associated sites. Ambulatory Neurological Services only discloses logged in user and commenter IP addresses under the same circumstances that it uses and discloses personally-identifying information as described below, except that commenter IP addresses and email addresses are visible and disclosed to the administrators of the site where the comment was left.

Gathering of Personally-Identifying Information

Certain visitors to Ambulatory Neurological Services' websites choose to interact with Ambulatory Neurological Services in ways that require Ambulatory Neurological Services to gather personally-identifying information. The amount and type of information that Ambulatory Neurological Services gathers depends on the nature of the interaction. For example, we may ask visitors to sign up at ANSEEG.com and provide a username and email address. Those who engage in transactions with Ambulatory Neurological Services are asked to provide additional information, including as necessary the personal and financial information required to process those transactions. In each case, Ambulatory Neurological Services collects such information only insofar as is necessary or appropriate to fulfill the purpose of the visitor's interaction with Ambulatory Neurological Services. Ambulatory Neurological Services does not disclose personally-identifying information other than as described below. And visitors can always refuse to supply personally-identifying information, with the caveat that it may prevent them from engaging in certain website-related activities.

Aggregated Statistics

Ambulatory Neurological Services may collect statistics about the behavior of visitors to its websites. Ambulatory Neurological Services may display this information publicly or provide it to others. However, Ambulatory Neurological Services does not disclose personally-identifying information other than as described below.

Protection of Certain Personally-Identifying Information

Ambulatory Neurological Services discloses potentially personally-identifying and personally-identifying information only to those of its employees, contractors and affiliated organizations that (i) need to know that information in order to process it on Ambulatory Neurological Services' behalf or to provide services available at Ambulatory Neurological Services' websites, and (ii) that have agreed not to disclose it to others. Some of those employees, contractors and affiliated organizations may be located outside of your home country; by using Ambulatory Neurological Services' websites, you consent to the transfer of such information to them. Ambulatory Neurological Services will not rent or sell potentially personally-identifying and personally-identifying information to anyone. Other than to its employees, contractors and affiliated organizations, as described above, Ambulatory Neurological Services discloses potentially personally-identifying and personally-identifying information only in response to a subpoena, court order or other governmental request, or when Ambulatory Neurological Services believes in good faith that disclosure is reasonably necessary to protect the property or rights of Ambulatory Neurological Services, third parties or the public at large. If you are a registered user of an Ambulatory Neurological Services website and have supplied your email address, Ambulatory Neurological Services may occasionally send you an email to tell you about new features, solicit your feedback, or just keep you up to date with what's going on with Ambulatory Neurological Services and our products. If you send us a request (for example via email or via one of our feedback mechanisms), we reserve the right to publish it in order to help us clarify or respond to your request or to help us support other users. Ambulatory Neurological Services takes all measures reasonably necessary to protect against the unauthorized access, use, alteration or destruction of potentially personally-identifying and personally-identifying information.

Cookies

A cookie is a string of information that a website stores on a visitor's computer, and that the visitor's browser provides to the website each time the visitor returns. Ambulatory Neurological Services uses cookies to help Ambulatory Neurological Services identify and track visitors, their usage of Ambulatory Neurological Services website, and their website access preferences. Ambulatory Neurological Services visitors who do not wish to have cookies placed on their computers should set their browsers to refuse cookies before using Ambulatory Neurological Services' websites, with the drawback that certain features of Ambulatory Neurological Services' websites may not function properly without the aid of cookies.

Business Transfers

If Ambulatory Neurological Services, or substantially all of its assets, were acquired, or in the unlikely event that Ambulatory Neurological Services goes out of business or enters bankruptcy, user information would be one of the assets that is transferred or acquired by a third party. You acknowledge that such transfers may occur, and that any acquirer of Ambulatory Neurological Services may continue to use your personal information as set forth in this policy.

Ads

Ads appearing on any of our websites may be delivered to users by advertising partners, who may set cookies. These cookies allow the ad server to recognize your computer each time they send you an online advertisement to compile information about you or others who use your computer.
